



# InCommon

Cultural and Educational Interventions  
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**InCommon is a project** funded by the Asylum, Integration, Migration Fund (AMIF) of the European Commission which consists of partners from Austria, Cyprus, Spain and Greece, **for the integration of refugees and migrants.**

The overall objective of InCommon is social inclusion through the cultural participation of migrant women. To achieve this aim, **three guidelines are established:**

- **Actions** for the empowerment of women through individual development and training on digital, interpersonal and civic skills and cultural expression.
- **Development** of a methodology for social inclusion through culture.
- **Creation** of networks consisting of communities, volunteers and cultural entities.

**InCommon is based on the fact that culture is a common good which is built with the participation of all members of a community.**

Participating in culture is to participate in the community, **having a voice and being a part of it.** To achieve this, we all need to have the tools and access to the resources that allow the fulfilment of this right.

**Local networks for citizen participation and social inclusion through culture.**

In our societies, there are many open-access high-quality cultural and educational resources. However, the reality is that they are not used by many groups, including migrant women. Likewise, the visions and perceptions of other cultures which are also part of the community are barely kept in mind in the organization and planning of cultural activities.

The InCommon project aims at **creating a direct dialogue channel** between the collectives of **migrant women and the local institutions** in order to break down barriers and facilitate the inclusion of diversity criteria **for social integration through culture.**

The ultimate goal is to create a local stakeholders network which complementary integrates these needs in its programme.
